- To earn a **gold** medal, read **1,500** minutes over the summer — an average of 30 minutes a day, five days a week.
- To earn a **silver** medal, read **1,000** minutes over the summer — an average of 20 minutes a day, five days a week.
- To earn a **bronze** medal, read **500** minutes over the summer — an average of 10 minutes a day, five days a week.
